# Workshop Outline

National Irish Safety Organisation, in conjunction with the Health and Safety Authority, is running a nationwide 2 hour workshop throughout 2023. The workshop will focus on supports for enterprises and employees along with providing updates on the Authority's strategy and programme of work.

Managing hazards and risks in the workplace is the foundation for a safe and healthy workplace and the provision of tools and resources for all stakeholders is critical to achieving this goal. The workshop will focus on new supports available from the Health and Safety Authority such as remote working, the role of the safety representative in the workplace, effective communication in the workplace and the free tools and resources that are available for employers and employees along with an overview of accident statistics and trends that are occurring in workplaces in Ireland.



## Workshop Objectives

This workshop is designed to support workplaces that are interested in understanding the key hazards and risks that are occurring in workplaces and the supports available. Participants will gain an understanding of:

- accident trends occurring in Ireland and the importance of accident reporting
- the core elements of managing a distributed remote workforce
- the role of the Safety Representative and how to ensure effective consultation in the workplace
- safety culture
- vulnerable workers and sensitive risk groups
- how to use the free tools and resources available and how to effectively communicate these to employees
